What is Lina?

Lina is a shared space for parents who live apart. It keeps practical information about the child — messages, contacts, medical details, photos, and belongings — organized and accessible in both homes. Only the two parents can see what is shared.

What's included

- Threaded messages — cannot be edited or deleted
- Shared photo album from both homes
- Child information: medical details, allergies, shoe size
- Shared contact list: school, doctor, emergency
- Equipment lists: what belongs where
- Care schedule overview

How to get started

1. Download Lina from the App Store or Google Play
2. Create an account with your email address
3. Invite the other parent using a code from the app

Good to know

- Free to use — no credit card required
- One Lina+ subscription covers both parents
- No advertising, no data sharing with third parties
- Private — only the two parents have access
